**Section 1.0 Title, Enactment, Effective Date,
Findings, Intent and Purpose**

1.1. Title

This Local Law shall be entitled "Local Law of 2003 of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, A Local Law Prohibiting Hunting and Trapping in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes hereby determines and finds that due to the development of the Village, the increase in the number and density of residents, families and their guests residing in and enjoying their properties, as well as the Village and its assets, and the proximity of their homes and properties, that hunting and trapping of all types imposes a severe hazard and threat to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, and their families and guests, and that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents and property owners to adopt a local law establishing regulations prohibiting hunting and trapping in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to protect the health, safety and well being of the residents of the Village of West Hampton Dunes, and their residents, families and guests through the banning of hunting and trapping in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Hunting and Trapping Prohibited

Hunting and trapping of all types is hereby prohibited within the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.2 Fines and Penalties

There shall be a fine of \$250 for each violation of this local law, plus such other penalty as a court of competent jurisdiction shall deem just and proper.

3.0 Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

**Section 1.0 Title, Enactment, Effective Date,
Findings, Intent and Purpose**

1.1. Title

This Local Law shall be entitled "Local Law of 2003 of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, A Local Law Establishing Regulations Regarding Predator Exclosures, Symbolic Fending and String Fencing in the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes."

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes hereby determines and finds as follows:

A. There has been a substantial restoration of homes and properties in the Village and a return in the Village to its pre-

existing number and density of residents, families and their guests residing in and of those families enjoying their properties, and which seek and are entitled to the use of the resources of the Village, including the beach areas of the Village, and that it is the obligation of the Village to provide access without unreasonable restriction to those assets and resources.

B. That the environment and surroundings of the Village have unique qualities and significance attributes including being the habitat for one or more endangered species.

C. That it is a primary goal of the Village, its Board of Trustees and officers and its residents to protect the environment and surroundings of the Village, its unique qualities and attributes, as well as the endangered species that have habitat in the Village.

D. That the ability of the Village, its Board of Trustees and officials, and the residents of the Village to achieve their goal of protecting the environment and surroundings of the Village and its unique qualities and attributes as well as the endangered species that maintain a habitat in the Village will be best served by the adoption of regulations regarding the use of predator exclosures, symbolic fencing and string fencing in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to adopt regulations which will protect the environment of the Village and its surroundings including the endangered species which have a habitat in the Village, to provide better and more consistent management and sharing of the resources of the Village consistent with the use of properties in the Village by their owners and their families by adopting regulations regarding the use of predator exclosures, symbolic fencing, and string fencing, and to maintain and provide for access without unreasonable restriction for the residents of the Village, their guests and the public to the assets and resources of the Village including but not limited to the beach areas.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Definitions

Board of Trustees; The Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

Endangered species; A species with a prior habitat in the Village of West Hampton Dunes which is considered endangered.

Exclosure; A fencing or other apparatus installed for the purpose of excluding predators from a nest.

Nest; A shelter made by a bird for holding the eggs of its young and in which there exists at least one egg.

Symbolic fencing; A fencing, marcation or similar apparatus made of string, ribbon, wire or similar materials which is installed for the purpose of excluding traffic or pedestrians a determined distance from a nest.

String fencing; A symbolic fencing made of string.

Village; The Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

Wildlife Administrator; Appointed administrator of wildlife of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.2 Regulations Regarding the Use of Predator Enclosures and Symbolic Fencing to Protect Endangered Species Nests

A. Authorization Required

1. Any person, entity, agency or party intending to construct or install a predator enclosure or symbolic fencing must first obtain a letter of authorization from the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2. Authorization letters should list any approved deviations from recommendations on enclosure design, construction, or monitoring provided in these regulations.

3. Authorization letters will not be issued for enclosures, symbolic fencing or string fencing on private property without the written authorization of the owners of that private property.

4. Symbolic fencing and string fencing will only be allowed for an endangered species nest with an endangered species

egg in the nest. Symbolic fencing and string fencing is limited to a radius of fifty (50) meters around a nest only.

5. Exclosures will only be authorized and may only be constructed after a full clutch of eggs has been confirmed by the Village, and exclosures will only be permitted by the Village under certain rare circumstances. Exclosures must be removed from the beach within a few days of hatching in order to reduce the probability that predators will habituate the exclosure.

6. The authorizations to be issued by the Village shall be issued by the Board of Trustees on the recommendation of the Wildlife Administrator.

3.0 Violations, Fines and Penalties, Remedies Not Exclusive

3.1 Violations

A. Any exclosure, symbolic fencing and string fencing which is installed by any party, entity, or individual which does not have the authorization of the Village of West Hampton Dunes as required by this local law or which is otherwise in violation of this local law is a violation of this local law.

B. Each and every day for which an exclosure, symbolic fencing or string fencing which is in violation of this local law shall be a separate violation and offense of this local law subject to a separate fine or penalty.

3.2 Fines and Penalties

An individual, entity, party or agency that is in violation or which shall commit a violation of this local law shall be subject to a fine of not less than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for each violation or offense.

3.3 Remedies Not Exclusive

The election by the Village of West Hampton Dunes to pursue either the prosecution of a violation or of a civil remedy shall not in any manner be deemed to be the election of an exclusive remedy and shall not preclude the Village from any other remedy that may be available to the Village.

4.0 Severability

In the event that any section or sections of this local law should be deemed to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining sections of the local law and the local law shall remain in full force and effect.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to establish a Village speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to establish a Village speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Establishing Speed Limit of Twenty-Five Miles per Hour

The Village speed limit on all roads and in all parts of the Village of West Hampton Dunes shall hereinafter be twenty-five

miles per hour.

2.2. Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

This Local Law shall be entitled "Local Law No. of 2003 of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, a Local Law Prohibiting Parking on Village Streets or Right of Ways."

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of

West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to prohibit parking on all Village Streets and public right of ways in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village and their guests and families by prohibiting parking on all Village streets and public right of ways in the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Parking Prohibited on All Village Streets and Public Right of Ways.

It shall and hereby is prohibited to park a motor vehicle of any kind on a Village Street or public right of way in the Village

of West Hampton Dunes.

2.2 Towing of Vehicles

The Village of West Hampton Dunes shall have the right to tow and remove any vehicle that is in violation of this Local Law, and all of the costs and expenses of the towing and removal including storage shall be the responsibility of the owner of the vehicle and shall be paid in full by cash or certified check prior to the release of a vehicle that has been towed or removed back to its owner.

2.3 Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

Hampton Dunes County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to adopt a Local Law amending the Non-Merger provisions of the Zoning Code of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to ensure proper planning and development in the Village and to protect the values of properties and the well-being of the residents of the Village and their guests and families.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Amendment to the Non-Merger Provisions of the Village Code of the Village of West Hampton Dunes

A. The following provision shall be added to the definition of a nonconforming lot in Section 330-5 of the Village Zoning Code.

In the event that the application or operation of the Non-Merger provisions of the Zoning Code of the Village of West Hampton Dunes are hereby amended to provide that in the event that the application or operation of the non-merger provisions to any parcel of property provisions a property results in the un-merger or deemed non-merger of lots in a parcel in an manner in which more than two lots will be un-merged, then the division or deemed non-merger of the lots shall be required to be approved by the Planning Board of the Village of West Hampton Dunes or the Board of Trustees serving as the Planning Board of the Village.

2.2. Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

1.1. Title

This Local Law shall be entitled "Local Law of 2003

Creating the Position of Alternate Members for the Zoning Board

of Appeals of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.”

1.2. Enactment

This Local Law is hereby enacted pursuant to Article 7 of the Village Law, Section 10 of the Home Rule Law, the General Municipal Law, and the Village Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, County of Suffolk and State of New York.

1.3. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4. Purpose and Intent of Local Law

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to create and provide for the position of two alternate members on the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of West Hampton Dunes in order to ensure and assist with the expeditious operation of the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village.

Section 2.0 General Provisions

2.1 Creation of the Position of Alternate Member, Qualifications, Duties and Obligations

A. Creation of Position

There shall hereby be created the position of Alternate Members of which there shall be two alternate members for the

Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

B. Qualifications of Alternate Members

The qualifications of an Alternate Member shall be the same as for any other member of the Board on which that alternate member is sitting.

C. Duties and Obligations

The duties and obligations of an Alternate Members shall be the same as for every other member of the Zoning Board of Appeals including but not limited to regular attendance at meetings of that Board.

2.2 Term of the Alternate Members

A. The term of each of the Alternate Members of the Zoning Board of Appeals shall be for five years and the initial appointments of Alternate Members shall be of a term to end on the last day of an administrative year of the Village so as not to exceed five years in length.

2.3 Appointment of Alternate Members

The Alternate Members shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of West Hampton Dunes and the appointment shall be approved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

2.4 Participation by an Alternate Member

Each of the Alternate Members may participate in the place of

any member of the Zoning Board of Appeals a member of the Board is either not participating in an application due to a conflict of interest, the reason for which has been stated to the Board in public, and also when a member of the Board is not in attendance due to absence.

2.5 Discretion of the Chairman of the Board

It shall be within the sole discretion of the Chairman of the Zoning Board of Appeals as to whether an Alternate Member to that Board shall participate and continue to participate in any particular application once a member of that Board has either indicated a conflict of interest or is absent at a hearing or meeting, or at a subsequent hearing or meeting on that application.

3.0. Severability

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

This Local Law shall be entitled "Local Law No. of 2003 of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, a Local Law Regulating Exterior Generators in the Village of West Hampton Dunes."

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village

Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to prohibit the use of generators outside of or on the exterior of homes and buildings between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. on weekdays and from 5:00 p.m. on Friday until 10:00 a.m. on Monday of each week.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village an their guests and families as well as the atmosphere and peace and tranquility of the Village by prohibiting the use of generators outside of or on the exterior of buildings during designated

times.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Use of Generators During Designated Times Prohibited.

It shall and hereby is prohibited for any person or party to use a generator or similar engine or machine outside of or on the exterior of any building or structure in the Village of West Hampton Dunes during the hours of 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m. on weekdays, from 5:00 p.m. on Fridays until 10:00 a.m. the following Monday, and at all times on weekdays and holidays.

2.2 Violations, Penalties and Fines

There shall be a fine or penalty of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for each and every violation of this local law, and each day that a violation shall exist shall be a separate violation of this local law.

The owner of the property on which the violation occurs and the contractor or other party that was performing the exterior construction shall both have committed an act in violation of this local law.

3.0 Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law and the Village Law of the State of New York the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4 Findings.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to establish regulations regarding drainage on properties and in particular to prohibit drainage off property or on to a public roadway from a driveway.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village an their guests and families as well as the atmosphere and peace and tranquility of the Village by regulating drainage and prohibiting

off property drainage from any property.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Drainage Plans

It shall and hereby is required for all building plans filed in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to show aspects of drainage from driveways on the respective property.

2.2 Driveways; Off-Premises Drainage Prohibited

It shall be and hereby is prohibited for the driveway of any property to drain off of the premises of the property and or onto any public roadway or right of way in the Village.

2.3 Violations, Fines and Penalties

Each violation of this local law shall be subject to a fine of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250), and each day that a violation shall exist shall be a separate violation of this local law.

3.0. Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law, Section 10(1)(a)(5) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, Section 18 of the Public Officers Law, and the Village Law of the State of New York, the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law of 2003, a Local Law of the Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of West Hampton Dunes.

1.4. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

A. Purpose

The purpose of this Local Law is to confer the benefits of Section 18 of the Public Officers Law on the officers and employees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes and to provide that the Village of West Hampton Dunes will incur the costs of providing those benefits to the officers and employees of the Village.

B. Intent

The intent of the Local law is to confer the benefits of Section 18 of the Public Officers Law on the officers and employees of the Village and to provide that the cost of conferring those benefits will be incurred by the Village.

1.5. Definitions

A. Officer. The term officer shall mean the Mayor, Trustee, member of the Board of Zoning Appeals, Planning Board, or other duly appointed or elected member of a Board as provided for in the Village Law or other law of the State of New York, any duly appointed Commissioner, Treasurer, Clerk, Village Attorney, and such other officers, including deputies, as the Board of Trustees shall appoint or determine.

B. Employee. The term employee shall mean any person working for the Village for wages or salary which is or are subject to the withholding of taxes, or any independent contractor, given employee status for the purpose of this local law, by resolution duly adopted by the Board of Trustees.

2.0 General Provisions

2.1 Provisions for Holding Harmless and Indemnification

A. The Village of West Hampton Dunes hereby confers the benefits of Section 18 of the Public Officers Law on the officers and employees of the Village and agrees to shall hold harmless and indemnify all officers and employees of the Village from financial loss and legal expenses arising from any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reason of any alleged past or future negligence or other act by such officer or employee at the time alleged, purported or actual damages were sustained was acting in the discharge of his or her duties and within the scope of his or

her employment and that such damages did not result from the willful and or wrongful act or gross negligence of such officer or employee and provided further that such officer or employee shall, within five days of the time he is served with any summons, compliant, process, notice, demand or pleading, deliver the original or a copy thereof to the either the Village Clerk or the Village Attorneys.

B. Upon the required delivery to the Village Clerk or the Village Attorneys, the Village Attorney or such other attorneys duly selected by the Board of Trustee may assume control and responsibility for the representation of the such officer and or employee of the Village. Such officer and or employee shall cooperate fully with the offices of the Village Attorney or the attorneys that are selected by the Village for representation in the defense of the claim or action.

C. This section shall not in any way impair, limit or modify the rights and obligations of any insurer under any policy of insurance.

D The benefits of this section shall inure only to officers and employees of the village and shall not enlarge or diminish the rights of any other party.

E. The Village will incur the costs of providing the benefits that are available under Section 18 of the Public Officers Law.

3.0 Severability

3.1 In the event that this local law or any portion of it is determined to be invalid or void then the remainder of the local law shall remain in full force and effect.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of West Hampton Dunes determines and finds that it is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners and guests, and of the preservation of good order and public safety in the Village of West Hampton Dunes to prohibit exterior construction until 8:00 a.m. on Monday of each week.

1.5. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village an their guests and families as well as the atmosphere and peace and tranquility of the Village by prohibiting exterior construction outside of or on the exterior of buildings during designated times.

2.0 General Provisions;

2.1 Exterior Construction During Designated Times Prohibited.

It shall and hereby is prohibited for any person or party to perform exterior construction outside of or on the exterior of any building or structure in the Village of West Hampton Dunes except as follows:

From Columbus Day to Memorial Day

Monday -Friday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Saturday 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Sunday- No Exterior Construction Permitted

From Memorial Day to Columbus Day

Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Saturday- No exterior construction permitted

Sunday- No exterior construction permitted

3.0 Violations, Penalties and Fines

There shall be a fine or penalty of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for each and every violation of this local law, and each day that a violation shall exist shall be a separate violation of this local law.

The owner of the property on which the violation occurs and the contractor or other party that was performing the exterior construction shall both have committed an act in violation of this local law.

4.0 Severability.

In the event that any section or portion of this Local Law

shall be deemed to be unenforceable or of no effect, the remainder of the Local Law shall survive and remain in full force and effect.
